DOSE RATE:

Sheep : 20-30 grams/head/day.
Cattle : 150-200 grams/head/day.

TIMING:

For supplementation when sheep or cattle typically scour and perform poorly on lush pastures.

THIS PRODUCT DOES NOT CONTAIN RESTRICTED ANIMAL MATERIAL.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Green Feed Energizer can be added to tubs or troughs and placed near water points or livestock camps. Once livestock are engaged with the lick, place containers further out in paddocks to better manage distribution of the lick across the mob. One container per 50 hd Sheep and 20 hd Cattle is recommended.

Ensure clean, fresh water is available at all times.

BEST BEFORE:

12 Months from date of Manufacture.

MEDICATED/NON MEDICATED:

Store in a cool dry place, out of direct sunlight.

BEST BEFORE:

Non Medicated.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD:

Nil Withholding.
