# **SUMMARY:**

Bran is a byproduct of flour manufacture. Bran consists of the outer layers of the wheat grain which is separated from wheat in the milling process. Wheat bran is palatable and widely used byproduct used in stock feed manufacture.

Wheat bran is light tan in colour and fibrous/fluffy.

Pigs young 0 Grower/ Finisher 5% - 10%

### WHEAT BRAN

- Bran is high in Phosphorus and low in Calcium, so care is needed in long term ration
   Formulation.
- Due to high fibre it can have a laxative effect should not be fed to very young stock.
- Useful for adding bulk to a ration.
- Palatable to most classes of livestock.
