Cobalt sulphate is a rose coloured chrySTALLINE product containing the trace mineral cobalt. Cobalt is a component of vitamin B12. All ruminants require cobalt in their diet for the synthesis of vitamin B12. Vitamin B12 is essential for energy metabolism and the production of red blood cells.

Cobalt is involved in in enzyme reactions, immune response, and the health of the nervous system.

Sheep are more susceptible to cobalt deficiency.

Sheep deficiency signs:

- reduced appetite & ill thrift (pica),
- anaemia
- scaly ears
- weepy eyes
- wool break.

Cattle deficiency signs:

- reduced appetite & ill thrift (pica)
- anaemia
- rough pale coat & reduced milk production
- scours in calves

Affected animals may eat bark, leaves, or dirt.

PACK SIZES: 2kg, 5kg, 25kg bags
