Ferrous sulphate is a grey powder containing the trace mineral iron, an essential element in livestock nutrition. Iron is required for the transport of oxygen, oxygen storage in muscle, and is also a component of energy production.

FERROUS SULPHATE/IRON

- About 60% of body Fe is in blood, as an essential part of haemoglobin.
- Deficiency symptoms include nutritional anaemia, fatigue, scours, changes to skin/hair condition, retarded growth, reduced appetite.
- Deficiency occurs mainly during rapid growth phases, young piglets susceptible.
- Iron deficiency is rarely seen in grazing animals as most forages provide adequate amounts.
- Iron is involved with cellular respiration, metabolism, activation of oxygen and electron transport, immune system.
