### SUMMARY:

Gypsum is naturally occurring Calcium Sulphate. It is yellow and sandy in nature and is a source of Calcium and Sulphur. Both Calcium and Sulphur are Macro minerals and required by all livestock.

Gypsum also has soil conditioning properties, increasing the water holding capacity of the soil.

### CONTAINS:

CALCIUM	23%
SULPHUR	18%

### FEEDING RATE

Gypsum can be included as a mineral supplement to Sheep grain rations to supply calcium and Sulphur. This can be added at 5-7kg per tonne of grain.
