SUMMARY

Molasses is a byproduct of the manufacture of sugar cane. Molasses is a thick black brownish liquid high in energy and very palatable to most livestock.

Molasses is an excellent complementary feed that improves palatability and digestibility of all feeds.

CONTAINS:

Typical Analysis

Dry Matter	75%
Crude Protein	5 % DM
Total Sugars	64% DM
ME Ruminants	9.6 mj/kgDM

FEEDING RATE:

Generally , 0.5 to 5% of ration , use as a palatant, energy source , and dust suppressant. Poultry 1 to 2%. Higher levels can be fed to ruminants , seek nutritional advice.

Molasses has a high Potassium & Salt content which can lead to scouring if fed in excess.
