Molasses is an excellent complementary feed that improves palatability and digestibility of all feeds.

FEEDING RATE:

Generally, 0.5 to 5% of ration, use as a palatant, energy source, and dust suppressant. Poultry 1 to 2%. Higher levels can be fed to ruminants, seek nutritional advice.

Molasses has a high Potassium & Salt content which can lead to scouring if fed in excess.
