WHEAT POLLARD

- Pollard is high in Phosphorus and low in Calcium so care is needed in long term ration
 - Formulation.
- Due to high fibre it can have a laxative effect should not be fed to very young stock.
- Useful for adding bulk to a ration.
- Palatable to most classes of livestock.
- Feeding rate is a guide only and professional advice should be sought for diet formulation.
