SUMMARY:

Poultry Grit [Calcium Carbonate], is a naturally occurring mined source of calcium sized as a 3 mm chip, which provides slow-release calcium and assists in the breakdown of grains in the chicken's gizzard. Calcium is an essential nutrient in the diet of poultry. Not only do chickens need to build and support healthy bones, but they also need enough free calcium in their diet to produce a hard eggshell.

CONTAINS:

Calcium as calcium carbonate 36% Ca 3 mm chip

DOSE RATE:

General inclusion rates

Feed ad lib to mature laying hens.

CALCIUM:

Calcium is the most abundant mineral element in the animal body. Calcium is an Essential element required daily.

About 90% of calcium occurs in the skeleton and is usually found in tandem with Phosphorous. Calcium provides hardness and structural strength to bones and teeth, about 1-2% of calcium is found in body fluids, as an essential mineral, Calcium is involved in nerve and muscle function, enzymes, blood clotting and a host of important body functions. Calcium and Phosphorous have a clear and known relationship, a ratio of 2:1 is usually a focal point in supplying correct levels.

Calcium deficiency in poultry can present as thin eggshells, poor hatchability, reduced egg production, poor egg quality, leg problems.

Calcium plays a major role in eggshell quality in laying hens.

Levels of Calcium are influenced by, age, genetics, level of productivity physiology, variability of ingredients, nutrient availability, stress, vitamin D intake, liver, and kidney integrity.
