

SODIUM BICARBONATE



SUMMARY:

Sodium Bicarbonate [baking soda] is a fine white powder commonly added to ruminant feeds as a buffering agent to maintain optimum rumen function. Feeding sodium bicarbonate assists in raising rumen PH, reducing the incidence of acidosis resulting from animals being fed high carbohydrate cereal grain diets.

DOSE RATE:

Dairy cows lactating 200 to 250 grams per head per day.

Beef Cattle on grain 10 to 20 kg /tonne feed, mixed thoroughly in feed, or 100 to 150 grams per head per day.

Sheep and lambs on grain 10 to 20 kg per tonne feed, mixed thoroughly in feed.
